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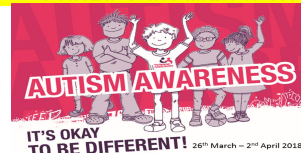

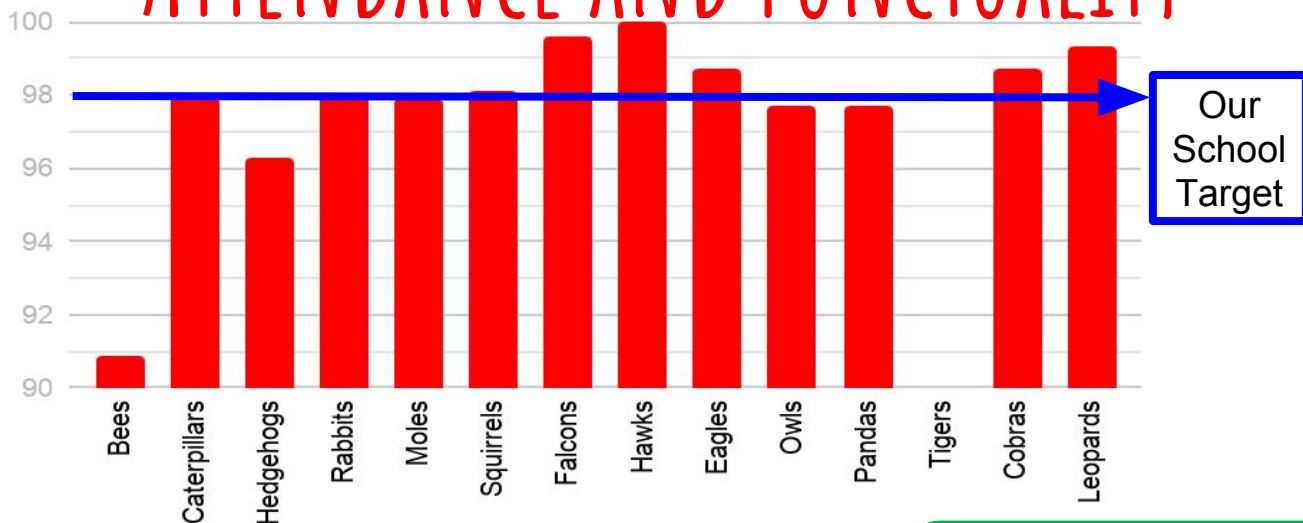

- Attendance Award (Attendance 98% or greater for the half term with no more than 1 late)
- Reading Award (Read at home every day & have reading diary signed)
